KINKS MENU

ROLE PLAY

- Octor/Nurse Play Playing out medical examination scenarios.
- Teacher/Student Playing with power dynamics an authoritative figure and a submissive one.
- O Pet Play One person acts as an animal (puppy, kitten) while the other acts as the handler.
- Age Play Involves one partner taking on a younger or older age persona.
- Uniform Play Involves dressing up in uniforms like police officers, military, etc.
- Fantasy Play Involves characters from movies, stories, or other fictional settings (e.g., superheroes, vampires).

BDSM SCENE

- **Bondage** Restricting a partner's movement with ropes, cuffs, or other restraints.
- Impact Play Spanking, flogging, caning, or other forms of hitting with consensual limits.
- Sensory Deprivation Using tools like blindfolds or earplugs to heighten other senses.
- Wax Play Pouring heated wax onto a partner's body
- Shibari Japanese rope bondage with intricate knot work for aesthetic and restraint.
- Sub/Dom Dynamics One partner takes on a dominant role while the other takes a submissive role, often involving power exchange.
- Knife Play Using knives for sensation, fear, or power dynamics without causing harm.



FETISHES

- Feet Arousal from feet or foot-related activities like massages or foot worship.
- Leather/Latex Attraction to leather/latex clothing or accessories and enjoying the sensation of wearing it.
- Wet & Messy (WAM) Arousal from being covered in substances like food, mud, or paint.
- Lingerie Arousal from wearing or seeing others wear specific types of lingerie or intimate clothing.
- Hair Fetis Arousal from hair, whether it's styling, length, or even specific types of hair.

CROSS DRESSING

- Sissification A submissive partner is "forced" or encouraged to dress in traditionally feminine clothing and act out female stereotypes.
- Orag Play Dressing up as the opposite gender for sexual or performative purposes.

EROTIC HUMILIATION

- Verbal Humiliation Using degrading or demeaning language consensually to increase arousal.
- O Public Humiliation Performing acts in front of an audience or knowing that others are aware of one's submissive acts.

KINKS MENU

NON-PHYSICAL KINKS

- Olirty Talk Arousal from using sexually explicit language during foreplay or sex.
- Hypnosis Play One partner puts the other in a trance-like state to explore different levels of control or submission.
- Fantasy Scenarios Involves mental stimulation through imagination, storytelling, or discussion of fantasies.

MEDICAL & EXAMINATION PLAY

- Needle Play Using needles for sensation and stimulation in a safe and consensual way.
- Enema Play Using enemas in a sexual context, often within medical role play.
- Speculum Play Involves gynecological examination role play with tools like a speculum.

EXHIBITIONISM & VOYEURISM

- Exhibitionism Enjoyment of performing sexual acts in public or semi-public spaces, with consent.
- **Voyeurism** Gaining arousal from watching others engage in sexual activities without them knowing (in a consensual context).
- Public Play Engaging in sexual activities in a public setting where others may see, with an element of risk.



SENSORY KINKS

- Tickling Gaining pleasure from tickling or being tickled as part of sexual play.
- Temperature Play Involves using ice or heat (such as warm hands or objects) to create a range of sensations.
- Sensual Massage Using oil and massage techniques to build arousal by focusing on the senses.

CONTROL & POWER DYNAMICS

- Orgasm Control (Edging) Controlling when a partner can reach climax by bringing them close and then stopping.
- Chastity Play One partner wears a device preventing them from sexual stimulation, controlled by the other partner.
- Financial Domination (Findom) A form of domination where the submissive gives money or financial control to the dominant partner.
- Cuckolding A submissive partner gains pleasure from knowing their dominant partner is with someone else sexually.
